Job Description LAUNDRY WORKER COUNTY HOME



SUMMARY

The laundry worker reports directly to the laundry supervisor. Oversees all laundry processes. Receives and sorts laundry, operates washers and dryers, treats stains and selects all cleaners. Repairs, mends, presses and folds laundry. Maintains the laundry area by ordering supplies, repairing machines and keeping area clean. Performs related work duties as needed.

PRINCIPLE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- I. Collects, receives, counts, and sorts laundry into separate loads by color, size, fabric type, and appropriate cleaning process. Removes unsalvageable materials from service. **Time spent: 25%**
- II. Operates washers, dryers and other laundry equipment, including computerized accessories; selects soaps and cleaning formulas. Adjust formulas for various types of soil, taking into account the fabric and dye of articles. Monitors gauges, sets timers on laundry equipment. **Time spent: 25%**
- III. Repairs and mends laundry. Replaces zippers and sews on buttons. Resets torn sections. Makes estimates of needed materials and determines which garments, towels, and cloths are salvageable and how repairs should be made. Orders replacement materials when directed by supervisor. Time spent: 20%
- IV. Finishes articles by drying, pressing, steam finishing and folding. Packs linen into bags or baskets and hangs or folds items of clothing. Restocks the laundry in storage. Time spent: 15%
- V. Performs routine and minor machine maintenance and repairs. Requisitions supplies and materials. Maintains records of time and materials. Observes standards for safety and cleanliness. Maintains cleanliness in laundry area. Attends staff meetings. Performs other duties as assigned. Time spent: 15%
